#### **VETERANS**

Vietnam Veterans Scholarship/Assistance for Veterans Chapter 299.

The application process is open from November 11, 2022, through February 28, 2023.

To qualify, the following is required:

- A veteran with 180 days of active service.
- Be a resident in one of the following counties: Warren, Henderson, Henry, McDonough, Mercer, or Rock Island in Illinois, and Scott County in Iowa.
- Attend an educational institution in one of the above counties.

Qualifications are based on the applicant's submission. Each applicant will be assigned to a scholarship(s) that meet the criteria of the fund.

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
